ADOPTING THE LANCASTER COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AS APPROVED BY THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY.

Be it resolved by the Council of Lancaster County, South Carolina:

<u>Section 1</u>. Approval of Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Lancaster County was notified by letter dated December 30, 2022 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency – US Department of Homeland Security that the Lancaster County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan was in compliance with the Federal Hazard Mitigation Planning requirements resulting from the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as contained in 44 CFR 201.6. The letter noted that effective December 19, 2022, the plan is approved for a period of five (5) years or until December 18, 2027.

Section 2. Adoption by County Council.

By way of Resolution Number 1226-R2023 the Lancaster County Council hereby adopts the Lancaster County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Section 3. Authority to Act.

The Council Chair, County Administrator, County Fire Rescue and Emergency Management Director and any other appropriate County official are each authorized to take such actions and to execute such documents as may be necessary to effectuate the purposes of this resolution and the implementation of the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Section 4. Severability.

If any section, subsection or clause of this resolution is held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, the validity of the remaining sections, subsections and clauses shall not be affected.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This resolution is effective upon its adoption.
