Fiscal Year 2023-2024 LANCASTER COUNTY BUDGET

The County of Lancaster will hold a public hearing on Monday, June 26, 2023 at 6:00pm in County Council Chambers, County Office Building, 101 N. Main St., 2nd floor, Lancaster, SC, for the purpose of obtaining written and oral comments from the public concerning the adoption of Ordinance 2023-1849 establishing the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 County Budget. Section 6-1-320(A)(1) of the S. C.
