RESOLUTION NO. 1269-R2024

A RESOLUTION

**DIRECTING THE LANCASTER COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICES DIVISION
TO POST SIGNAGE SETTING THE MAXIMUM SPEED ON REGENT PARKWAY IN
LANCASTER COUNTY AT 25 MILES PER HOUR.**

Be it resolved by the Council of Lancaster County, South Carolina:

Section 1. Findings.

- Whereas: Regent Parkway is a county owned and maintained roadway; and
- Whereas: Regent Parkway has certain design features which require a lower speed limit than the current posted speed limit of 35 miles per hour; and
- Whereas: The Lancaster County Council finds it would be in the best interest of the public to reduce the speed limit along the roadway from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour with regulatory speed limit signs on both eastbound and westbound approaches to Regent Parkway; and
- Whereas: The reduced speed limit along the roadway from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour would match the section of Regent Parkway on the York County side of the roadway.

Section 2. Adoption by County Council.

By way of Resolution Number 1269-R2024 the Lancaster County Council hereby directs the Lancaster County Public Services Division to post appropriate signage reducing the speed limit from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour on Regent Parkway in Lancaster County.

Section 3. Effective date.

This Resolution is effective upon its adoption.
