A RESOLUTION

TO AMEND THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING AND THE SCOPE OF THE LANCASTER COUNTY CORONER'S OFFICE BUILDING FROM EXPANSION TO NEW CONSTRUCTION.

WHEREAS, The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) was signed into law on March 11, 2021 and provides direct funding to state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, Lancaster County has been allotted over \$19 million and all funds have been received by Lancaster County; and

WHEREAS, County management has identified a list of projects that fit the eligibility criteria for ARPA funds and those projects were prioritized by the County Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Lancaster County initially reviewed the priority list and believed that the Lancaster County Coroner's Office Building Expansion was a project of high priority and immediate need; and

WHEREAS, as a result of a change in the scope of work needed for the Lancaster County Coroner's Office Building, an increase in the allocated American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) funding is necessary in order to amend the work from an expansion to new construction; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide for the funding necessary to amend the previously approved work on the Lancaster County Coroner's Office from an expansion to new construction, an amount of \$1,000,000.00 from un-allocated ARPA funds will be utilized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Lancaster County authorizes an amendment in the expenditure of ARPA funds on the Lancaster County Coroner's Office up to an amount of \$1,000,000.00 from un-allocated ARPA funds for a total potential expenditure of \$2,770,000.00 and directs and authorizes the County Administrator to take all necessary steps to effectuate the amendment of ARPA funds and the scope for the listed project.
